Invitation to the Nelson Mandela Museum Media Breakfast Session

The Nelson Mandela Museum invites Media Houses to a Media Breakfast Session that is scheduled to take place at the Nelson Mandela Museum Bhunga Building site in Mthatha. The planned media breakfast session will take place on the 30th of June 2023 at 08h00 until 10h00.

The Chief Executive Officer of the Nelson Mandela Museum Dr. Vuyani Gweki Boo will inform and update the media and the public on the extended historical sites to be administered by the Museum that include the OR Tambo Garden of Remembrance in Nkantolo Bizana and the Ingquza Hill Memorial Site in Flgastaff. Dr Boo will also unpack the museum's year-long activities to commemorate the 10th anniversary of Nelson Mandela's passing on under the theme: **Preserving His Legacy and Living His Values: Remembering Madiba**. Some of the programmes that will commemorate his passing will be held during Mandela Month:

- **Handing over of the library (67 minutes)**
- **Unveiling of two statues of Nelson Mandela – one as Statesman and the other as a traditionalist**
- **Nelson Mandela Museum International Public Lecture**

The President of the country will be unveiling the two statues and the Minister of DSAC will officiate the International Public Memorial Lecture.
