Background

The Nelson Mandela Museum is a not for profit institution established by South Africa's government as an agency of the National Department of Arts and Culture. It was established as part of a portfolio of legacy projects that seek to transform the heritage landscape from the apartheid past. At the same time, it is a resource for promoting economic development through tourism in an impoverished region. The museum primarily houses collections of gifts

given by Nelson Mandela to the museum to share his legacy with the nation.

The mandate of the Nelson Mandela Museum (NMM) is to preserve and promote Nelson Mandela's legacy. One of its main strategic goals is to improve the museum's public profile and access. This mandate is executed through the museum's four main facilities, the Qunu Youth and Heritage Centre, Bhunga Building, Ingquza Hill Museum in Flagstaff, and OR Tambo Garden of Remembrance in Bizana (eNkantolo). The Bhunga Building doubles as the

administrative office of the museum.
