MEC for DSRAC to hand over a library

The Nelson Mandela Museum in partnership with the Department of Sport, Recreation, Arts and Culture (DSRAC) and the department of Education will be handing over a school library at Asherville High School in Graff Reiniet on the 31st of August 2021.
