1. Background information

The Nelson Mandela Museum (NMM) invites quotations from accredited service providers that are registered with the Central Supplier Database (CSD) for conducting research at the Nelson Mandela foot prints for the purpose of a developing a booklet and exhibition plan.

2. Objective

The objective of this request for quotation is to appoint a suitably qualified and experienced service provider to conduct research on the identified areas: Mvezo; Qunu; Mhqekezweni; Qokolweni; and Clarkeburry for the purpose of developing a booklet and exhibition plan.

3. Scope of work

The successful service provider will submit a research proposal for consideration and approval by the NMM. The proposal will cover five areas: Mvezo; Qunu; Mhqekezweni; Qokolweni; and Clarkeburry. The research purpose scope and approach should be to develop a booklet and content for exhibition development by the Nelson Mandela Museum. At least not less than 60 people should be interviewed from the identified areas.

4. Technical Requirements

- Research- Expertise in both desktop and field research
- Experience in interviewing research respondent
- Experience in oral history/literature reviews

- Knowledge and experience of research in heritage space
- Experience in publishing a booklet for knowledge sharing purpose
- Knowledge and understanding of the Museum/Heritage Sector
- Has some exposure and understanding heritage and conservation

5. Evaluation Process

5.1. Stage 1: Returnable Documents:

Prospective service providers must comply with the requirements and submit all required document(s) indicated hereunder with the bid documents at the closing date and time of the bid. This phase is not scored and bidders who fail to comply with all the mandatory criteria may be disqualified.
