> SCOPE OF WORK

Nelson Mandela Museum is looking for suitable service provider to provide payroll services

which will ensure accurate and timely processing of employee salaries, benefits and

deductions while complying with relevant laws and regulations. This service provider will

handle various aspects of the payroll management system, including salary calculations, tax

deductions, benefits administration and statutory compliance. They also maintain employee

records, generate payroll reports and ensure financial confidentiality.

The service provider will also be instrumental in maintaining strong relationships with

employees, finance departments and external stakeholders such as tax authorities and

regulatory bodies. The service provider must possess in-depth knowledge of payroll systems,

accounting principles, labour laws and taxation requirements.

> OBJECTIVES OF THIS ROLE

- Overseeing end-to-end payroll processing, including salary calculations, deductions and benefits administration, such as provident fund/Pension, insurance and healthcare plans/ Medical aid.

- (c) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "the Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

# 3. FORMULAE FOR PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES

#### 3.1. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

# 3.1.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

# 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR SPECIFIC GOALS

4.1. In terms of Regulation 4(2); 5(2); 6(2) and 7(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded for specific goals stated in the tender. For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based

- on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
